FAKE ID'S

**FIVE STEP
ID CHECK**

- 1 Ask for an ID and Match the Customer with the Photo
- 2 Look for a RED BAR indicating the Customer is Underage
- 3 Calculate the Customer's Age
- 4 Check the Expiration Date
- 5 Check for Tampering (Match Last Digit of Audit # and Date of Birth)

Know the Law:
It is illegal for any person 21
or older to purchase or provide
alcohol to minors.
Fines are up to \$2,500
or 1 year in jail.

WHO SHOULD ATTEND

Anyone who sells alcohol, e.g. clerks, servers, managers, owners of liquor stores, bars, groceries, convenience stores, etc.

WHY ATTEND

Learn how to spot fake IDs, know the current law about sales to minors, and how to keep yourself and your business compliant with the state law. Also, learn how to identify if an adult is buying for minors and effective ways to address it.

WHEN AND WHERE

Alcohol responsible retailer training is scheduled to take place right after to the monthly "Iowa Pledge" tobacco compliance training on September 25th (last Tuesday of each month) at 6:30 pm.
